BOYS

GIRLS

HAIR: No unusual "fad" cuts or hair color. Hair must be clean cut and well groomed. Must be worn above the eyebrows and may not hang below the earlobe or rest on the collar in back.

NAILS: Must be clean and trimmed.

<u>JEWELRY:</u> Medical bracelets, wristwatches, and religious medals on a plain gold or silver chain permitted. No earrings allowed.

<u>BODY:</u> No piercings or permanent/temporary tattoos. Body must be clean of ink and marker.

HAIR: No unusual "fad" cuts or hair color. Hair must be clean cut and well groomed. Accessories must coordinate with uniform. School approved headband & scrunchies permitted.

NAILS: Must be clean and trimmed. No false nails or polish permitted.

<u>JEWELRY:</u> Medical bracelets, wristwatches, and religious medals on a plain gold or silver chain permitted. May wear post earrings only-no hoops.

BODY: No piercings or permanent/temporary tattoos. Body must be clean of ink and marker. Use of makeup (including lip gloss) is not permitted.

SLACKS: Navy twill pants year round.

SHORTS: Navy twill shorts prior to Nov. I and after March 31.

SHIRTS: Blue (optional: SAS logo) polo (short & long sleeved), blue button down collar shirt (short & long sleeved), and blue turtleneck.

SWEATERS: Navy v-neck pullover sweater & navy vest.

PREFERRED MASS UNIFORM:

- Blue button down collar shirt
- Navy vest/sweater
- · Blue plaid tie
- Navy twill pants
- · Belt
- White, navy, or black socks (no ankle socks)
- Solid black, brown, or navy rubber soled shoes.

* All students <u>MUST</u> wear the school uniform on days when Mass is celebrated (no dress down passes).





<u>SLACKS:</u> Navy or khaki twill pants year round.

SHORTS: Navy or khaki twill shorts prior to *Nov. I and after March 31*.

SHIRTS: Ash, cardinal, or navy (optional: SAS logo) polo (short & long sleeved), white button down collar shirt (short & long sleeved), and navy turtleneck.

<u>SWEATERS:</u> Cardinal or navy v-neck pullover sweater & cardinal or navy vest.

PREFERRED MASS UNIFORM:

- White button down collar shirt (short or long sleeved)
- Cardinal or navy vest/sweater
- · Blue plaid tie
- · Navy or khaki twill pants
- Belt
- White, navy, or black socks (no ankle socks)
- Solid black, brown, or navy rubber soled shoes.

* All students <u>MUST</u> wear the school uniform on days when Mass is celebrated (no dress down passes).





























TIE: Blue plaid tie

SOCKS: Navy, white, or black

BELT: Black or brown belt (no cloth)

SHOES: Black, brown, or navy standard, flat, non-marking rubber-soled shoes

SLACKS: Navy twill pants year round.

SKORTS: Navy skorts prior to Nov. I and after March 31. Skort hems no shorter than 2" above the knee.

SKIRTS: Blue plaid 4 kick pleated skirt. Skirt hems no shorter than 2" above the knee.

<u>JUMPERS:</u> Blue plaid split front jumper or blue plaid drop waist jumper.

SHIRTS: Blue (optional: SAS logo) polo (short & long sleeved), blue button down collar shirt/blouse (short & long sleeved), blue peter pan collar blouse (short & long sleeved) and blue turtleneck.

SWEATERS: Navy v-neck pullover sweater & navy crew neck cardigan sweater.

PREFERRED MASS UNIFORM:

- Blue button down or peter pan collar shirt/blouse
- Navy sweater/cardigan
- Coordinating hair accessories
- Jumper or skirt
- · Navy tights or knee high socks
- Solid black or brown rubber soled shoes.

* All students <u>MUST</u> wear the school uniform on days when Mass is celebrated (no dress down passes).













*The white blouse is pictured only to showcase the jumpers. White shirts are not permitted in grades K-5.

SLACKS: Navy or khaki flat front pants year round.

SKORTS: Navy skorts prior to Nov. I and after March 31. Skort hems no shorter than 2" above the knee.

SKIRTS: Navy or khaki 4 kick pleat skirt or grey 2 panel skort (can be worn year round). Skirt hems no shorter than 2" above the knee.


SHIRTS: Ash, cardinal, or navy (optional: SAS logo) polo (short & long sleeved), white button down collar shirt/blouse (short & long sleeved), white 34 length sleeve blouse and navy turtleneck.

<u>SWEATERS:</u> Cardinal or navy v-neck pullover sweater & cardinal or navy v-neck cardigan.

PREFERRED MASS UNIFORM:

- White button down collar shirt/blouse (short or long sleeved)
- Cardinal or navy sweater/cardigan
- Coordinating hair accessories
- Navy or khaki skirts
- Navy knee high socks or tights
- Solid black or brown rubber soled shoes.

* All students <u>MUST</u> wear the school uniform on days when Mass is celebrated (no dress down passes).

























HAIR ACCESSORIES: All hair accessories must coordinate with school uniform.

KNEE HIGH SOCKS: Solid navy. Must be worn with skirt or jumper from Nov. I-March 31.

TIGHTS: Solid navy. Must be worn with skirt or jumper from Nov. I-March 31.

SOCKS: Navy, white, or black socks must cover ankle bone. No logos permitted.

BELT: Black or brown belt (no cloth)

SHOES: Black, brown, or navy standard, flat, non-marking rubber-soled shoes

<u>SHORTS:</u> Lycra athletic style shorts must be worn under skirt or jumper. Lycra shorts must be a dark color.

K-8APPROVED GYM UNIFORM



Must be purchased from FLYNN & O'HARA and it will have the SAS logo (NO SUBSTITUTIONS):

- Navy t-shirt
- Navy shorts. No shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
- Navy sweatshirt (scoop neck or hooded)
- Navy sweatpants. Must be worn from Nov. I-March 31.
- White athletic socks covering the anklebone
- Sneakers (no lights, characters, or wheels)
- *Approved spirit wear may also be worn with the gym uniform- Knights of Faith t-shirt & long sleeved navy SAS t-shirt
- *Sweatshirts (scoop neck or hooded) may also be worn in the classroom with the regular uniform

NON-UNIFORM (DRESS DOWN) DAYS

Dress must be modest and in keeping with Diocesan policy.
T-shirts must be in keeping with good taste. Nothing suggestive or offensive permitted.

Shoes must be flat (no heels) and have backs.

SAS does not permit spandex shorts to be worn as shorts alone. They may only be worn underneath dresses or skirts that are no shorter than two inches above the knee. Spandex shorts must be dark in color.

Leggings are only permitted if the top worn falls within three inches of the knee.

Strapless or spaghetti strap tops are not permitted unless a sweater or cardigan is worn over the garment at all times. Shoulders may not be exposed. Clothing that has been cut, torn, or excessively decorated is not permitted.

UNIFORM EXCHANGE:

- Uniform items may also be available through the uniform exchange.
- Please visit the school office to shop the uniform exchange.
- If your child has outgrown clothing, please consider donating it to the exchange.
- If you have any financial difficulties adhering to this policy please contact the secretary or principal.

VIOLATIONS:

- Any student in violation of the policy will be given written warning from the child's teacher.
- After three warnings, the student will be sent to the office for a behavior notice and parent contact will be made to correct the situation.
- Faculty/staff reserve the right to deny any student any activity if they feel dress or shoes pose a safety issue.
